The use of And / or / but

Los usamos para expresar lo siguiente

English	Spanish
And	Y
Or	O (responde a la pregunta Which do you prefer? = ¿Qué prefieres?)
But	Pero

AND

Une ideas
similares
(afirmación)

I can paint **and** swim

Puedo pintar **y** nadar

OR

Une ideas
alternativas
(negación)

I can't paint **or** swim

No puedo pintar **o** nadar

BUT

Une ideas
contrastantes
(af. y neg.)

I can paint **but** I can't swim

Puedo pintar **pero** no puedo nadar

Examples of AND

English	Spanish
I can play soccer and rugby	Puedo jugar futbol y rugby
She likes to play tennis and swimming	A ella le gusta jugar tenis y nadar

Examples of OR

English	Spanish
Which do you prefer tennis or swimming?	¿Cuál prefieres tenis o nadar?
Which do you prefer soccer or roller blading?	¿Cuál prefieres futbol o andar en patines?

Examples of BUT

English	Spanish
I love the beach but I can't swim	Amo la playa pero no puedo nadar
I like football but I don't like tennis	Me gusta el futbol pero no me gusta el tenis
