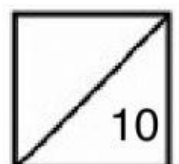
Watch out for tenses!

5. Mr Wadsworth has a disgusting habit. He chews on his nails for breakfast, lunch and dinner. (For example)

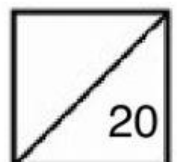
6. The boy lost his wallet. Someone returned his wallet to him. (Fortunately)

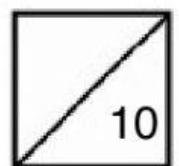
