

PRESENT PERFECT WITH JUST / ALREADY

1) MAKE SENTENCES USING THE WORDS IN PARENTHESES AND THE WORD **JUST**.

EXAMPLE: I **HAVE JUST MET** my new neighbor. (met)

- a) I my finger! (cut)
- b) He his new car! (crash)
- c) I at the office. (arrive)
- d) My husband to work. (leave)
- e) Mary lunch. She's not hungry. (have)
- f) I reading the paper. You can take it. (finish)
- g) I that I forgot to lock the door. Let's go back. (remember)
- h) Peter to the manager. He will help us. (talk)
- i) I the apartment. Take off your dirty shoes! (clean)
- j) Grandma a shower and she is ready to go. (take)
- k) I the dog. Don't give him more food. (feed)
- l) The drier . Our clothes are dry. (stop)
- m) The show . You haven't missed anything. (start)
- n) The server your dish. It's still hot. (bring)
- o) I the house of my dreams. Let's celebrate! (buy)

2) MAKE SENTENCES USING THE WORDS IN PARENTHESES AND THE WORD **ALREADY**.

EXAMPLE: I **HAVE ALREADY TRIED** sushi. (try)

- a) I to Europe. (be)
- b) I this movie. It's so funny! (watch)
- c) I the computer. You use it now. (use)
- d) I this book. It's really beautiful. (read)
- e) If you your homework, you can play. (do)
- f) I lunch. We aren't going to eat out. (cook)
- g) He to me. Everything is fine. (talk)
- h) Judy to her new house. (move)
- i) Adam the medication. Now he will feel better. (take)
- j) I abroad. (travel)
- k) I to the grocery store today. I won't go there again! (be)
- l) They everybody to the wedding. (invite)
- m) The movie . Hurry up! (start)
- n) My grandpa . Now he's finally enjoying life a bit. (retire)
- o) We breakfast. We're ready to go now. (have)
