




SIMPLE PRESENT

<u>Use:</u>	Always	Sometimes	every (day, week, month, year,...)
	Usually	Seldom /Rarely	once/twice ... a (week, month, year,...)
	Often	Never	at weekends

I We You They	The verb doesn't change	I always clean my room. They clean their room on Fridays. You often clean your room at weekends We never clean our room.
She He It	* The verb adds "s" * verbs ending in  add "es" * verbs ending in y vowel + y add "s" consonant + y "y" turns into -ies	She usually cleans her room in the morning. KISS The girl kisses the baby. WATCH Daniel watches soap operas. GO He goes to school by bike. MIX My mum mixes all the ingredients in a bowl. PLAY Susan plays handball. CARRY The boy carries a heavy school bag.

I We You They	don't	clean the room. kiss the baby watch TV. go to school. mix the colours
She He It	doesn't	

I watch TV on Wednesday.
I **don't** watch TV on Thursdays.

She **cleans** her room every day.
She **doesn't** clean her room at weekends.
