

Pronouns

What are pronouns?

I	me	we	us	you
	they	them	he	him
		her	it	

Information:

Pronouns are used in place of nouns (naming words) to avoid having to repeat the noun.

Examples

Clara is excited. Clara is going on holiday today.
(Clara is the noun.)

Clara is excited. **She** is going on holiday today.
(**She** is the pronoun used to avoid repeating the name, Clara.)

Example

Pronouns

There were three elephants in the zoo. The elephants were huge. The zoo keeper was feeding the elephants.

There were three elephants in the zoo. **They** were huge. The Zoo keeper was feeding **them**.

(The pronouns **they** and **them** have been used to avoid repeating the word, elephants.)

(Elephants is the noun.)
