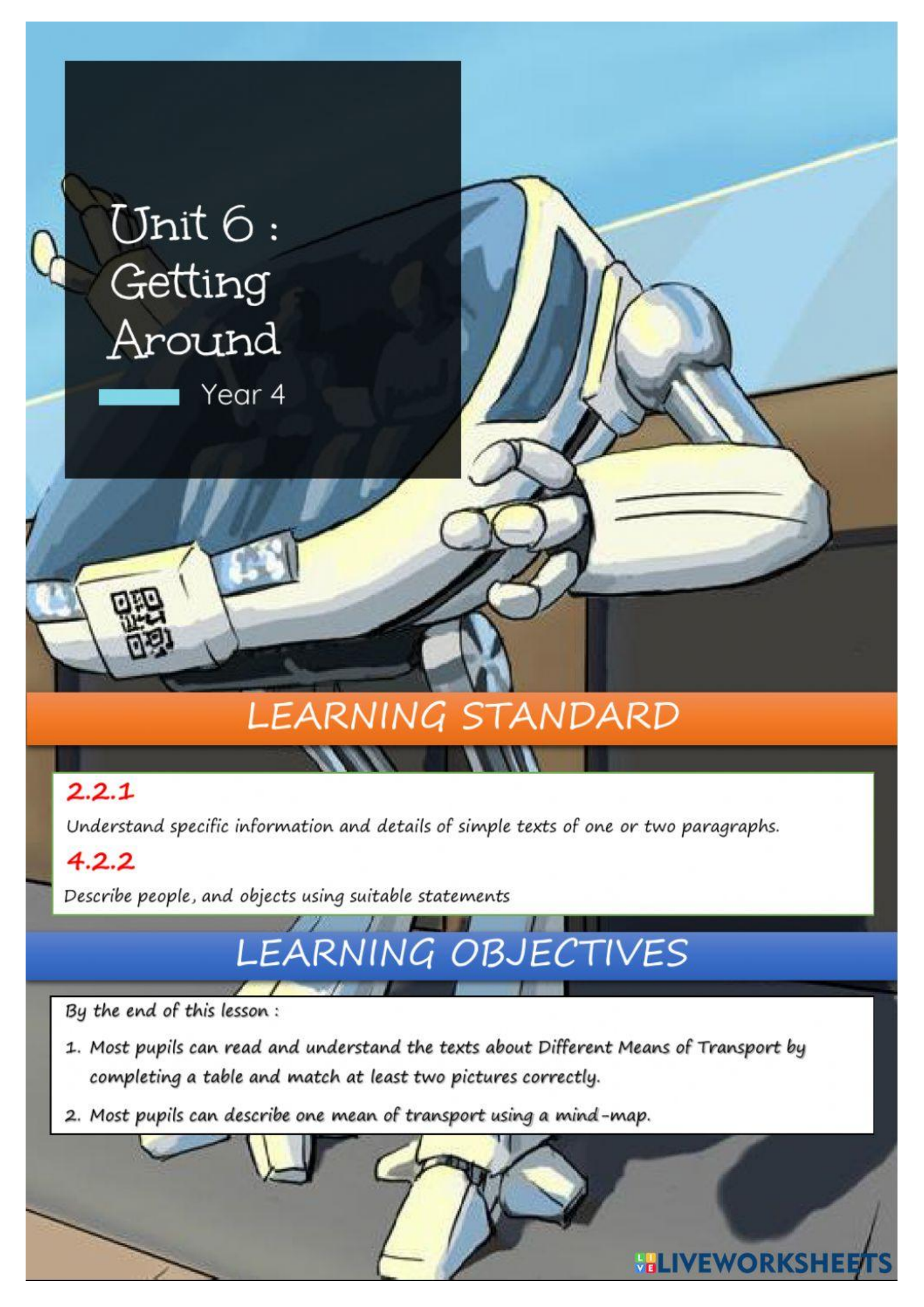

Different Means of Transport
