AVENGERS – Captain America



Captain America is a fictional superhero appearing in American comic books published by Marvel Comics. **Created** by cartoonists Joe Simon and Jack Kirby, the character first **appeared** in *Captain America Comics* (cover dated March 1941) from Timely Comics, a predecessor of Marvel Comics. Captain America was designed as a patriotic supersoldier who **often fought** the Axis powers of World War II and was Timely Comics' most **popular** character during the wartime **period**. The popularity of superheroes waned following the **war** and the *Captain America* comic book was discontinued in 1950, **with** a short-lived **revival** in 1953. Since Marvel Comics revived the character in 1964, Captain America has **remained** in **publication**.
