## BICYCLES PART 1

### COMMUNITY BASED INSTRUCTION

\_\_\_\_\_ HAVE THE SAME RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES AS VEHICLE AND  
MOTORCYCLE DRIVERS INCLUDING:

- 1) OBEYING ALL TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SIGNAL \_\_\_\_\_.

RIDING.



- 10) MAKING LEFT AND RIGHT TURNS IN THE SAME WAY \_\_\_\_\_ DO, USING  
THE SAME TURN LANES. IF THE BICYCLIST IS TRAVELING STRAIGHT AHEAD, THEY

SHOULD USE A THROUGH TRAFFIC LANE \_\_\_\_\_ THAN RIDE NEXT TO THE CURB AND BLOCK TRAFFIC MAKING RIGHT TURNS.

11) BICYCLISTS SHALL NOT OPERATE A BICYCLE ON A ROADWAY UNLESS THE BICYCLE IS \_\_\_\_\_ WITH A BRAKE WHICH WILL ENABLE THE OPERATOR TO MAKE A ONE-WHEEL SKID ON DRY, LEVEL, CLEAN \_\_\_\_\_.
