

### SOME – ANY

	Countable nouns	Uncountable nouns
	Plural	
<b>Affirmative</b>	There are <b>some</b> tomatoes.	There is <b>some</b> bread.
<b>Negative</b>	There aren't <b>any</b> tomatoes.	There isn't <b>any</b> bread.
<b>Interrogative</b>	Are there <b>any</b> tomatoes?	Is there <b>any</b> bread?

**Note:** We use **some** in interrogative sentences for offers. Would you like **some** tea?
