How to make Korean Lemon Tea

7. Place a desired amount of lemon and honey (sugar) juice in a cup.

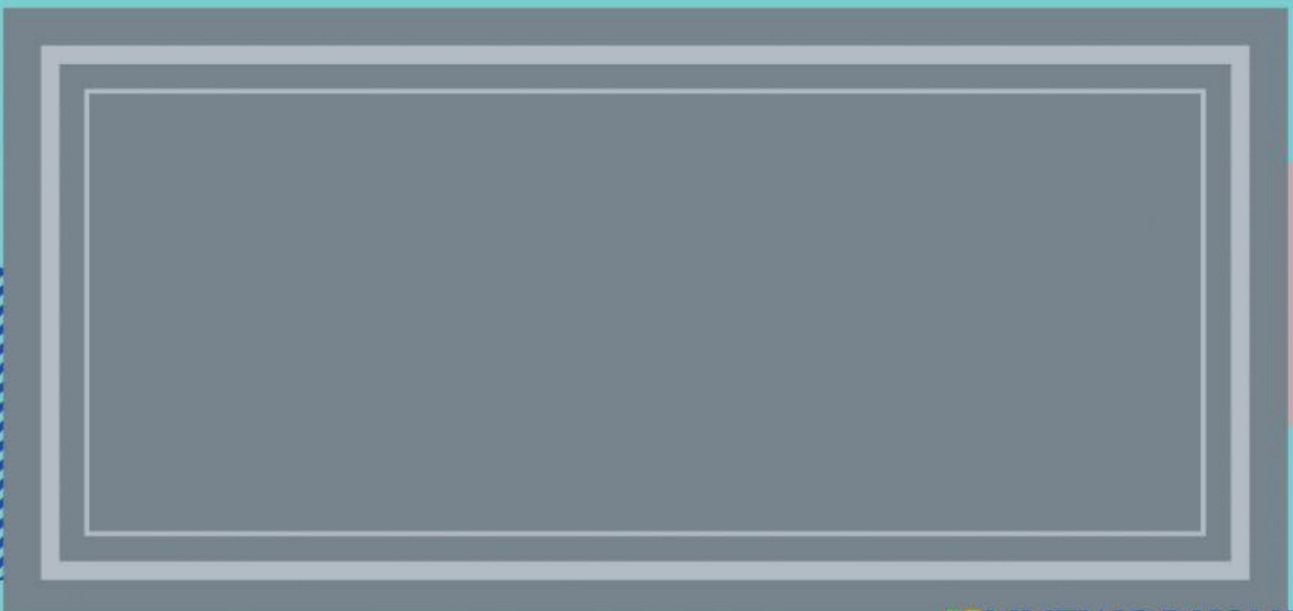
Pour hot water into the cup. Stir it well and a cup of Korean lemon tea is ready to drink.



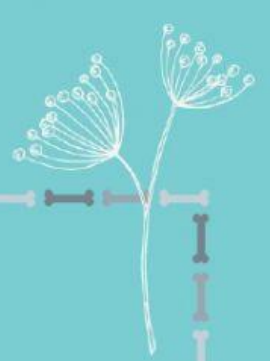

Here are the steps to make a cup of Korean lemon tea. First, prepare the ingredients. We need 4 lemons, 5 teaspoons of honey or sugar and a cup of hot water. Second, wash the lemons and slice them. Next, fill up a jar with the sliced lemons and honey or sugar. Then shut the jar tight and leave overnight in room temperature. After 24 hours, open the jar. The next step is, place a desired amount of lemon and honey (sugar) juice in a cup. After that, pour hot water into the cup. Last, stir it well and a cup of Korean lemon tea is ready to drink.
