Adverbs finished in -LY	Lonely - More lonely He is more lonely than before	Lonely – the most lonely Tommy is the most lonely child at school.
Long adjectives	Expensive – more expensive than This apartment is more expensive than this other one	Expensive – the most expensive This is the most expensive computer I have ever seen.

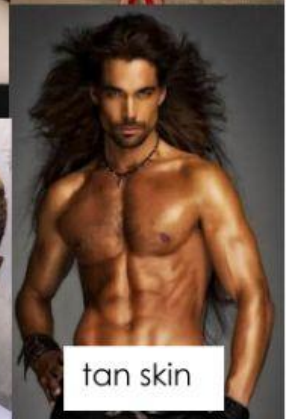
