1 THE GRAND CANYON, USA

This **canyon** in the middle of a **desert** is nearly 2 km deep! You can go rafting down the Colorado **River** at the bottom of the **valley**.

2 THE GREAT BARRIER REEF, AUSTRALIA

In the Pacific **Ocean**, near the **coast** of Queensland, this coral **reef** has over 1,500 different kinds of fish!

3 THE AMAZON RAINFOREST, ECUADOR

The world's biggest **forest** is full of plants and animals, which are disappearing as people cut trees down.

4 THE DEAD SEA, JORDAN

This is a **lake** of salty water which you can float in. On the **beach**, there is a special kind of mud which people put on their bodies!

5 THE NIAGARA FALLS, CANADA

At Niagara there are three different **waterfalls**. About 5 million litres of water go through them every second!

6 TABLE MOUNTAIN, SOUTH AFRICA

This **mountain**, which is flat on top, has steep **cliffs** you can climb, and all kinds of wildlife.

7 THE BLUE CAVE, GREECE

Inside this **cave** on the Greek **island** of Kastelorizo the water is a beautiful deep blue.
