Bermuda triangle



The Bermuda triangle has long been called the devil's triangle or a mysterious area of the Atlantic Ocean since **(1. a number of/ a large amount of)** ships and planes have gone missing. This sea area is surrounded by Bermuda, Puerto Rico and Miami. In here, compasses don't work. So, what happened there? why is this place so famous? and has anyone or anything been

found yet?

This area is about 500,000 square meters and one of the earliest sailor Christopher Columbus who sailed here once recorded a great flame of fire **(2. falling into/ rising from)** this area and there are some strange lights appearing a few weeks later. 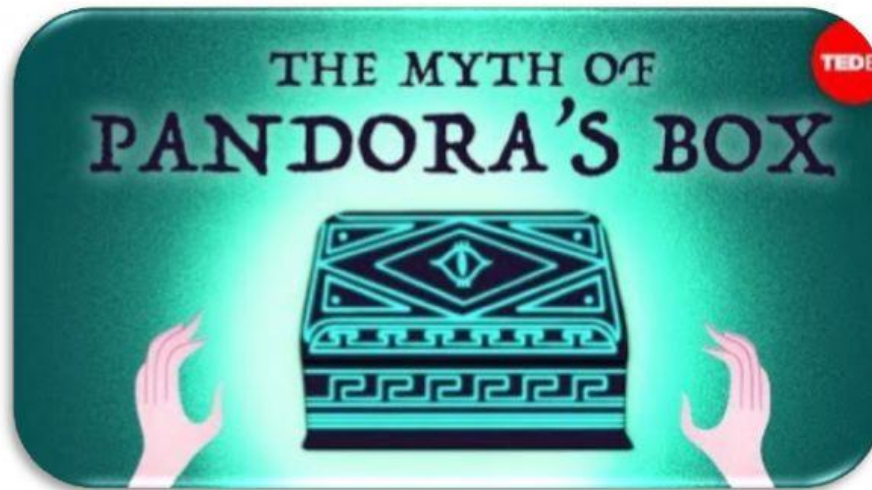
