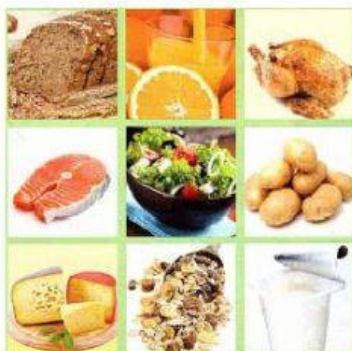
Yes, there is. /

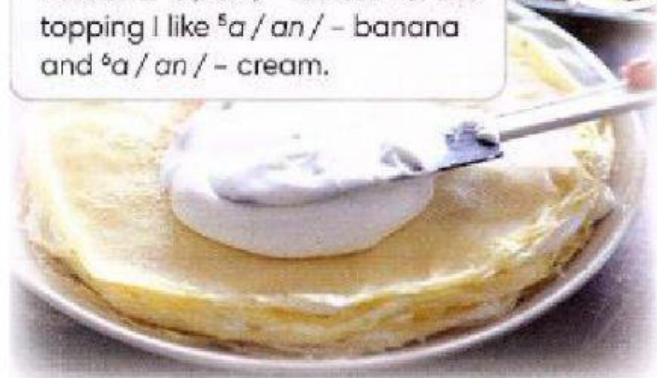
