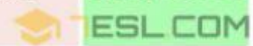


ENGLISH PRONOUNS

1st person	I	me	my	mine	myself
2nd person	you	you	your	yours	yourself
3rd person (male)	he	him	his	his	himself
3rd person (female)	she	her	her	hers	herself
3rd thing	it	it	its	(not used)	itself
1st person (Plural)	we	us	our	ours	ourselves
2nd person (Plural)	you	you	your	yours	yourselves
3rd person and thing (Plural)	they	them	their	theirs	themselves



*Object pronouns comes after the verb in a sentence.

Example:

1. I bought this cake yesterday. This cake belongs to **me**.

Saya telah membeli kek ini semalam. Kek ini adalah hak milik saya.

2. You bought the towel last week. The towel belongs to **you**.

Awak telah membeli tuala itu pada minggu lepas. Tuala itu adalah hak milik awak.

3. He bought the racket just now. The racket belongs to **him**.

Dia telah membeli raket itu sebentar tadi. Raket itu adalah hak milik dia.

4. She bought a pair of shoes last night. The pair of shoes belongs to **her**.

Dia telah membeli sepasang kasut malam tadi. Pasangan kasut ini adalah hak milik dia.
