## ● The Dodo



The Earth is home to many different kinds of wildlife, but some species no longer exist today. These are known as extinct animals. Once a species becomes extinct, it is gone forever. the most common cause of extinction is a sudden change of a species' habitat.

A habitat is the environment in which an animal lives. If there is too much change, they can rarely survive. Their food supply, shelter, and other things they need to survive can be wiped out.




