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Choosing my topic

Choose a topic that 1.....you so that it is easy to speak about it. Make sure that you know, or can 2....., enough grammar and vocabulary to be able to speak about it.

Preparing my topic

You must prepare a mind map with five discussion points on it. This will help you to 3.....what you want to say. You can also take one or two photos or objects into the exam to illustrate your topic. Do not memorize your topic! If the examiner thinks you have memorised it, she/he will automatically interrupt you.

Length of topic

The topic section of the exam is no more than 5 minutes, 4.....some ideas on your topic, as you will have a discussion about it with the examiner.

How to create a mind map

- Write the title of the topic in the middle
- 5.....five ideas about the topic around the title.
- Then think of 3 or 4 sentences for each idea.
- Make sure you are using Grade 5 language as much as possible in your sentences.
- At least one of your sentences must be a question that you ask the examiner.
