

WHAT IS A FLAG?

The colours of flags

A flag is a piece of fabric*. It is generally rectangular or square* and it is of various colours. The study of flags is called "vexillology" from the Latin word *vexillum* meaning flag.

A flag is used for various purposes*: a **national flag** is the symbol of a country; **international flags** are used for associations of countries, for example the olympic flag or the flag of the European Union or of the United Nations.

The colours are very important in a flag and the most common colours on a flag are:



Red is a very common colour in flags: it is the symbol of strength*, courage, bravery*, revolution, the blood of the soldiers



Green is traditionally a colour associated with nature, agriculture and fertility and in general connected with positive feelings of hope* and love



Blue is commonly connected with sea and sky but in flags it is the symbol of justice and peace.



Yellow is connected to sun and wealth*. It is used in the flags of many African nations to indicate sunshine*.

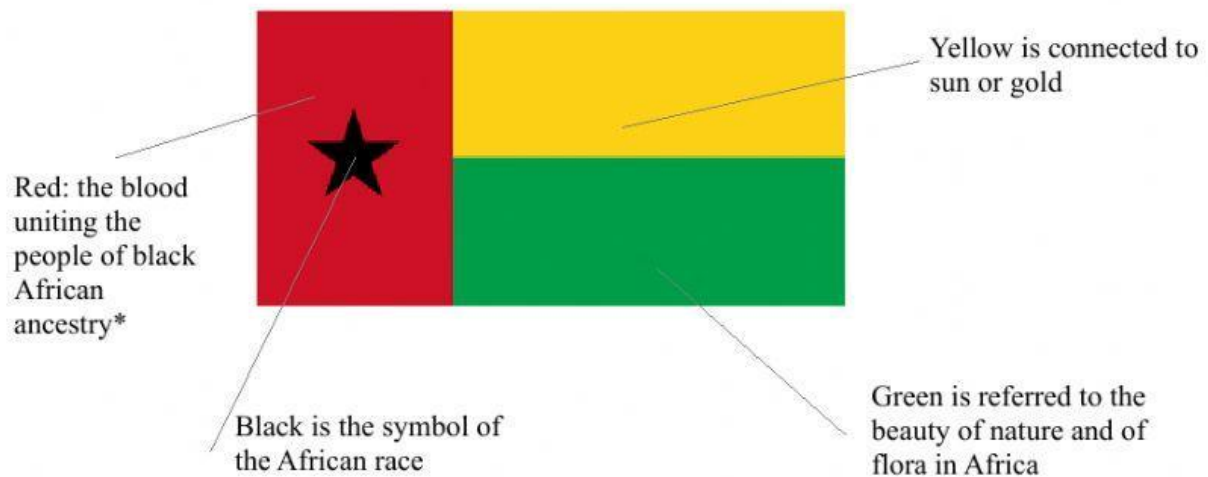


Black is usually a symbol of struggle*, determination, ethnic heritage* and fortitude.

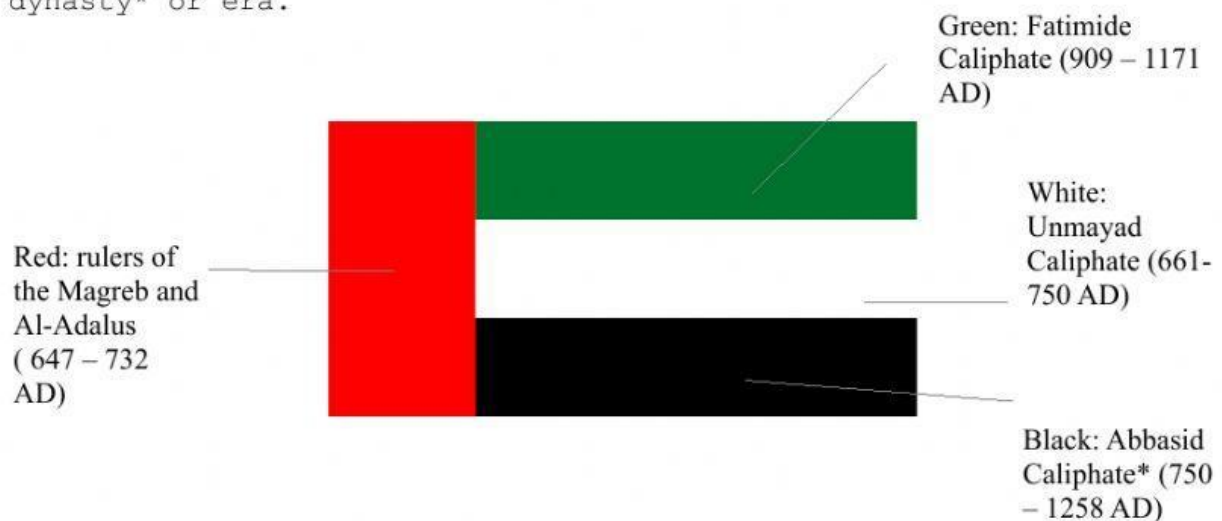


White is symbol of peace, purity and innocence.

Pan-Africanism: is the idea that African countries are united by an ethnic bond. The usual colours and their meanings* are:



Pan-Arabic colours: they are the colours first combined in the flag of the Arab revolt in 1916. They are connected to a specific Arab dynasty* or era.



The most common forms on a flag are: stars, the moon (usually a crescent moon, symbol of the Islamic religion), constellations*, the

sun, a circle, a cross (symbol of the Christian religion), a coat of arms*, an eagle.

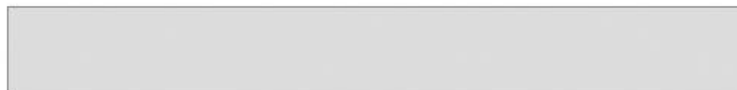
