USUALLY, SOMETIMES, NEVER, OFTEN, ALWAYS, GENERALLY, HARDLY EVER are placed **after** verb **TO BE** (AM IS ARE), but **before** the other verbs

My best friend **always** **GOES** to the club with her sister

My best friend **IS** **always** in the club with her sister

EVERY morning/afternoon, etc, EVERY DAY, ON Mondays/ Saturdays, etc/ ON WEEKDAYS, ONCE A YEAR, THREE TIMES A YEAR van siempre al comienzo o al final de la oración

Every morning my best friend goes to the club with her sister.

My best friend goes to the club with her sister **every morning**.
