**BUKIT JALIL NATIONAL STADIUM**



Bukit Jalil National Stadium is situated in the city of Kuala Lumpur. It was built on 1 January 1995 to host the 1998 Commonwealth Games. To make it more meaningful, the construction took exactly three years to complete, which was on 1 January 1998. The 4th Prime Minister, Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad, inaugurated the facility. Currently, the stadium is being operated by KL Sports City.

The cost to build Bukit Jalil National Stadium was RM 800 million. With the maximum capacity of 87,411, the stadium is the largest in Southeast Asia. It was built by United Engineers Malaysia (UEM) Berhad and was completed 3 months ahead of schedule. Designed to host various kind of events, it is considered as the best stadium in Malaysia.

In 1998, the stadium became a major attraction when our country hosted the Commonwealth Games. Athletes from all over the world came and competed at the prestigious venue. After the games, Bukit Jalil National Stadium became the home ground for the Malaysia national football team. It has become the main venue for international football matches. The major sporting event that was held recently was the 2017 Southeast Asian Games, which the national stadium was the main venue for athletics event.

Before Bukit Jalil sports complex was constructed, the national stadium was located in the heart of Kuala Lumpur city centre, Merdeka Stadium. The facility is also historical as it was the venue when the declaration of Malaysia's independence took place. It was also the home ground of our national football team. Nevertheless, Malaysia also uses other stadiums for football matches such as KLFA Stadium, Hang Jebat Stadium and the Shah Alam Stadium.
