These demonstrators feel the spirit of People Power which succeeded in overthrowing the corrupt regime of Ferdinand Marcos in 1986.

In 2005, a study conducted by Transparency International reported that more than 62% of Indians had first-hand experience of paying bribes or nepotism to complete work at public offices. Two years later, a report from the same organization revealed that about 40% of Indians had first-hand experience of paying bribes and nepotism. According to Transparency International in 2012, India was 94th most corrupt country together with Benin, Colombia, Djibouti, Greece, Moldova, Mongolia, and Senegal.
