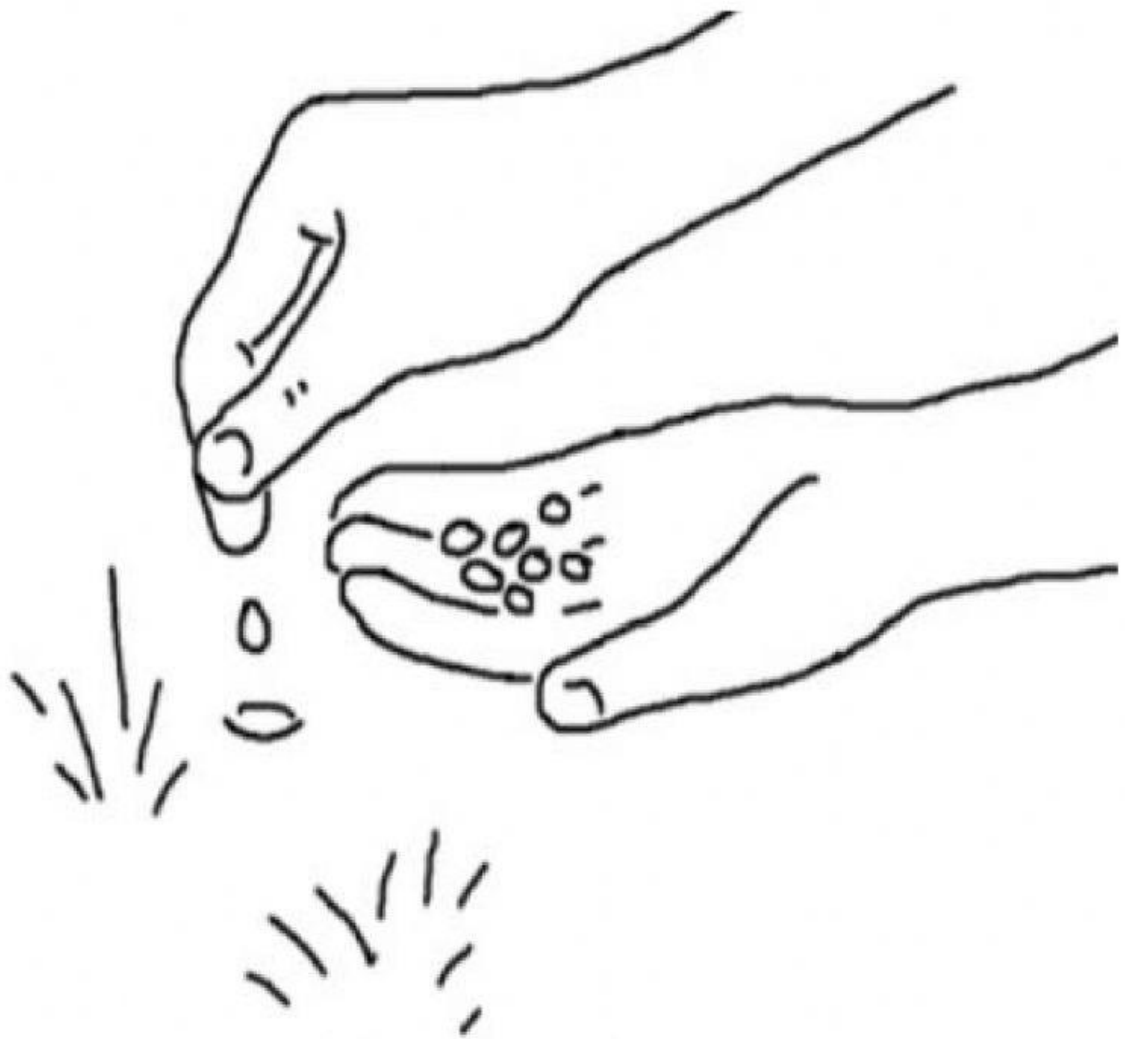

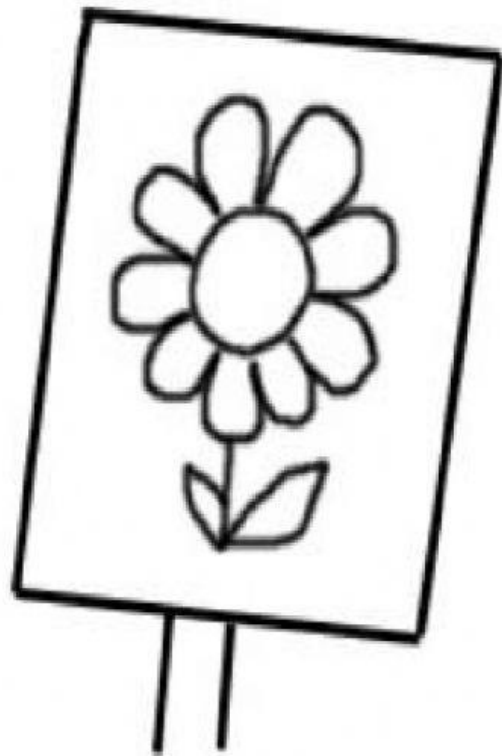

Planting Seeds

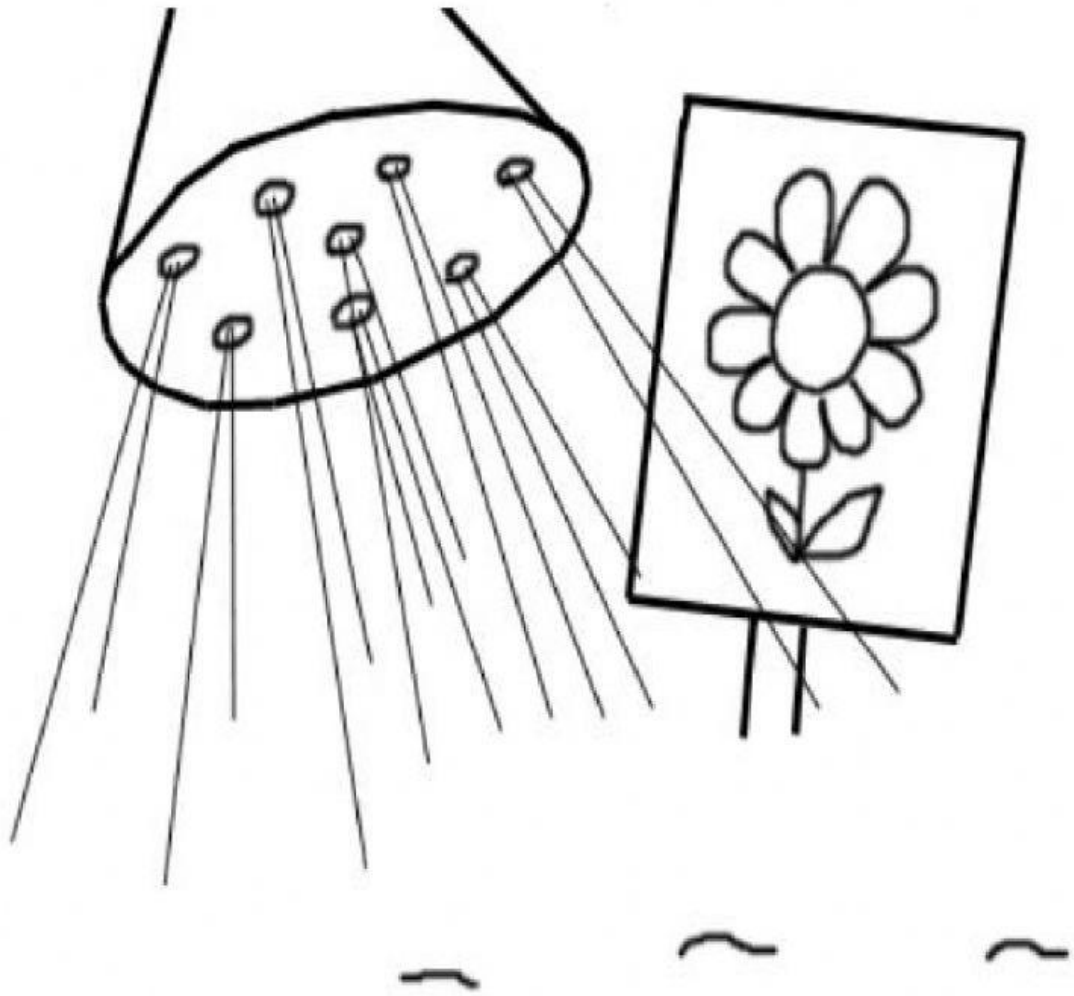




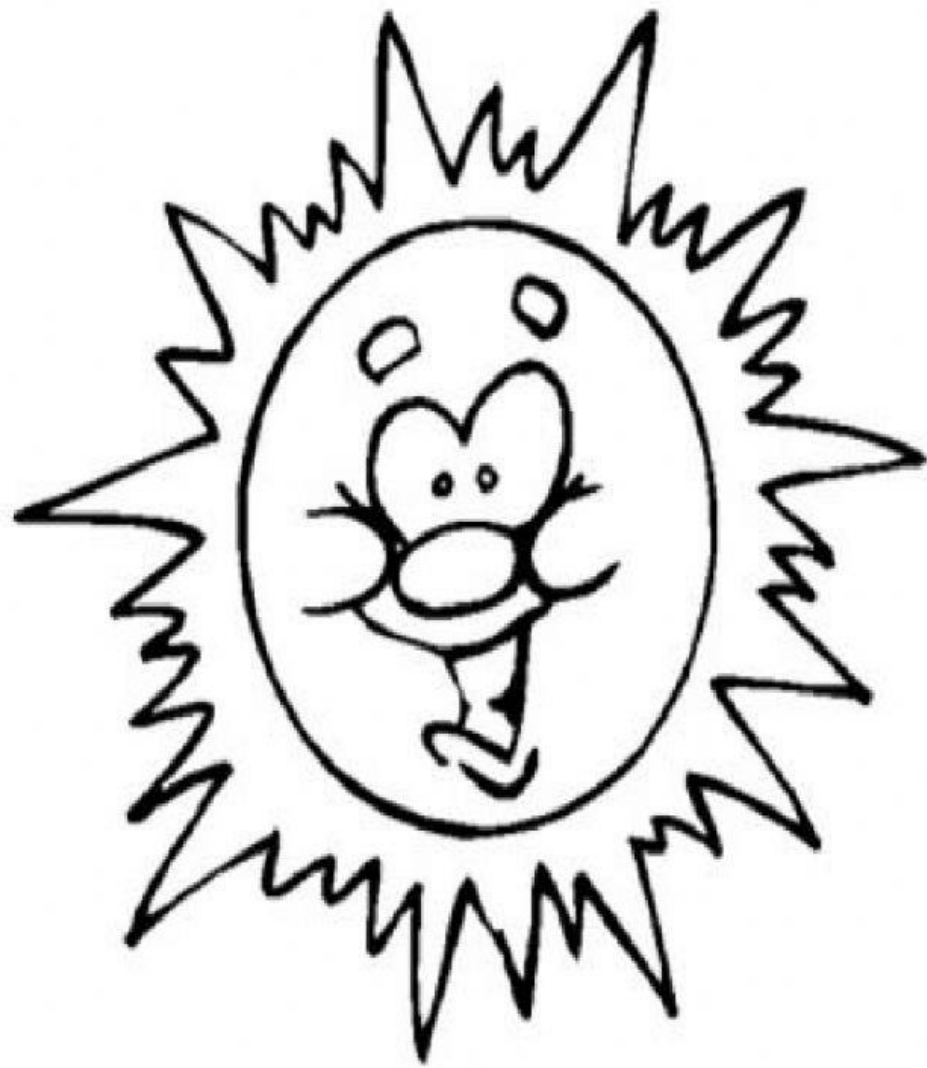
Plant a flat seed in the ground.
Now you pat it all around.



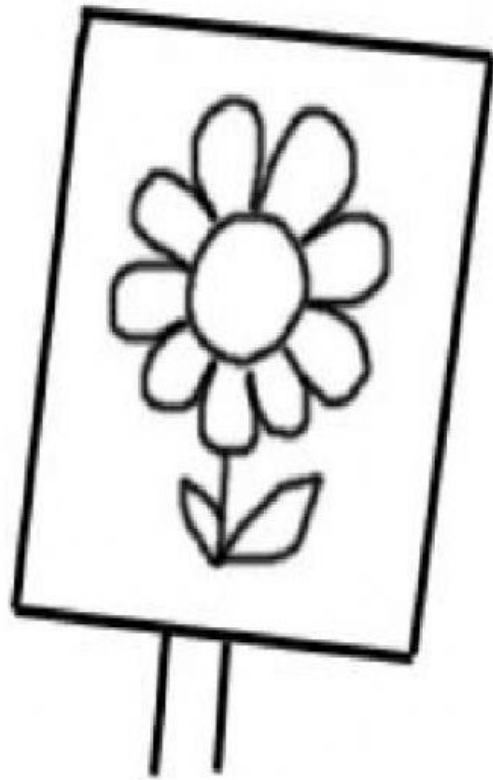
Use your hand to pat it flat.
Place a marker where it's at.



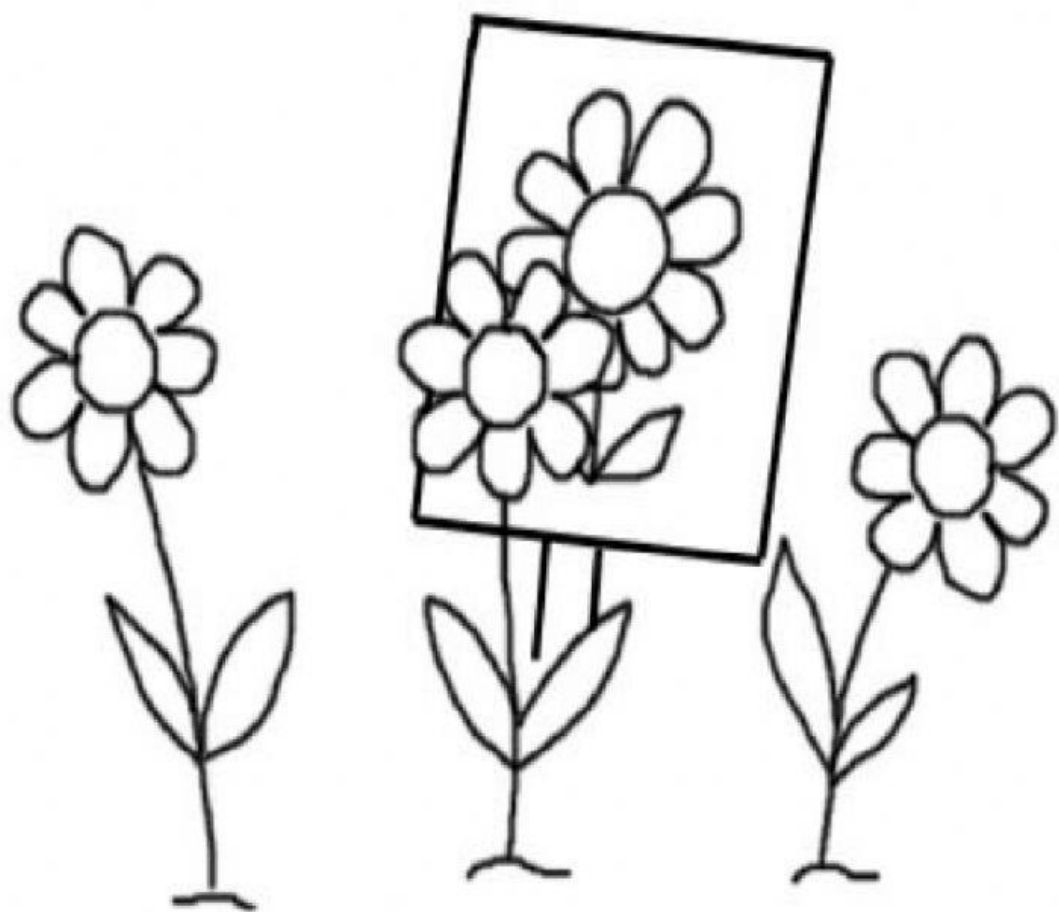
Water it and wait for sun.
