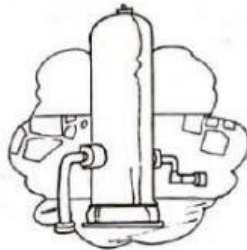

Advantages of E-Books

In the modern era today, e-books have taken over regular books, which we may still find in bookshops. There are too many good things about e-books in general, and that may be the reason why it has become extremely famous today.

For one, e-books are pretty handy in terms of saving storage and space. Books are physically heavy and takes up space when left in bookshelves and boxes at home. With an e-book, one may keep millions of books in a single hand-held device: the only limit being the storage memory in one's device.
