

Object Questions	Subject questions
Most common type of questions. The normal rules that you learn about making questions, such word order and the auxiliary verb. <u>We want to know about the object.</u> - What do you like? I like <u>ice cream</u>. - What did you have for breakfast? I had <u>pancakes</u>. - Where did you go yesterday? I went <u>to the mall</u>. - Where is the car? The car is in <u>the garage</u>.	We don't need to use auxiliary verbs. We generally make subject questions using 'who' or 'what'. We want to know about the <u>subject</u>. - Who likes ice cream? <u>Sandra</u> likes ice cream. - Who had pancakes for breakfast? <u>Alex</u> had pancakes for breakfast. - Who went with you? <u>My best friend</u> went with me. - What is in the garage? <u>The car</u> is in the garage.
