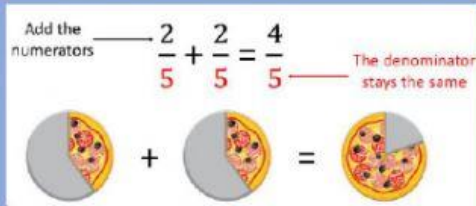


Adding/Subtracting Fractions



$$3\frac{3}{5} - 2\frac{1}{2}$$

$$= (3 - 2) + \left(\frac{3}{5} - \frac{1}{2}\right)$$

$$= 1 + \frac{6}{10} - \frac{5}{10}$$

$$= 1\frac{1}{10}$$
