1. Order

- Leave now!
- Don't move anything!

2. Advice

- Eat less and do exercise more.
- Don't smoke for your better health.

3. Instruction

- Go straight. Turn right at the corner.

4. Request

- Please, sit down at your seat.
- Let me join the group, please.

- Look out!
- Be careful! Don't go!
