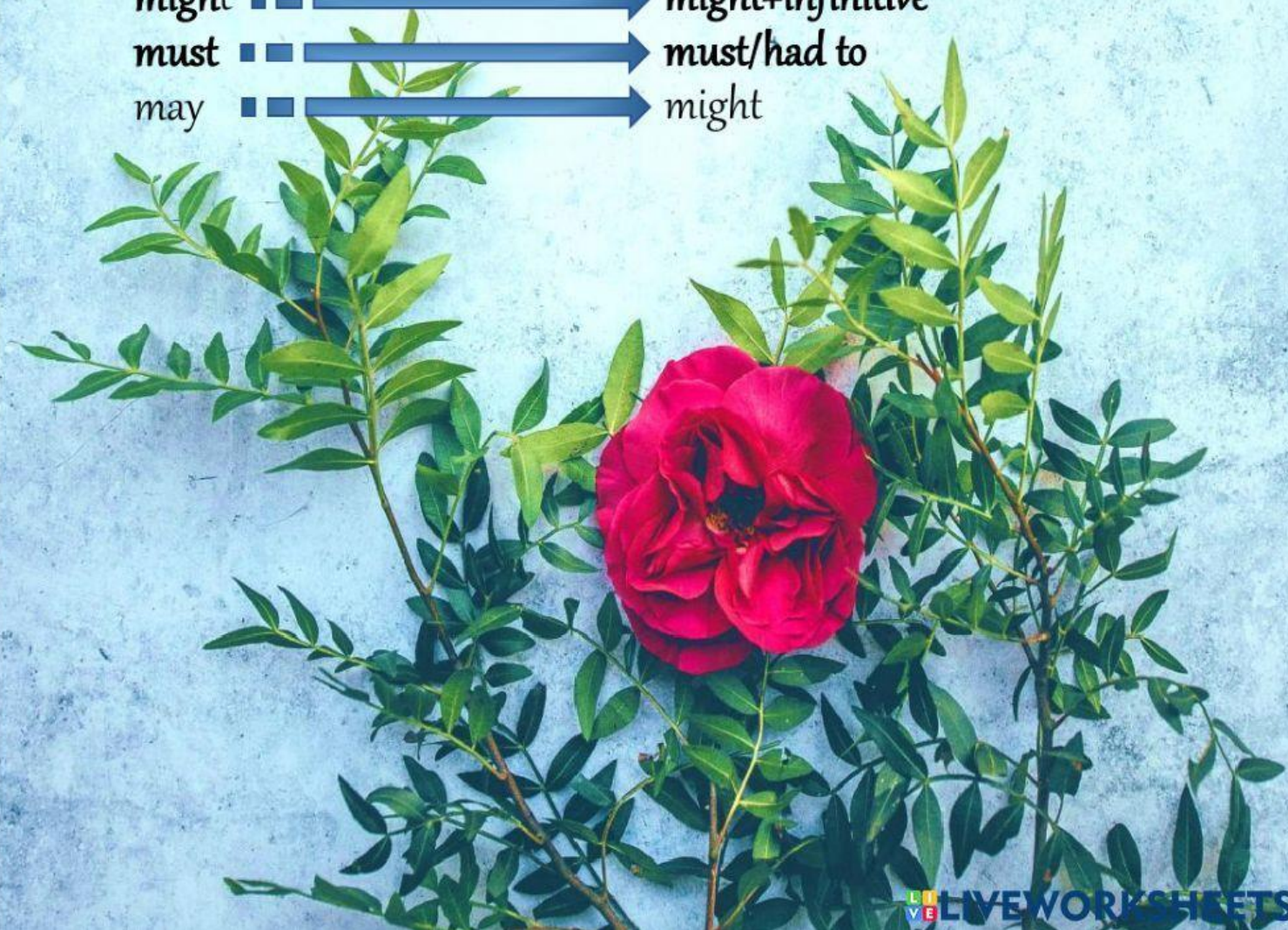


Sequence of Tenses

Present Continuous	→	Past Continuous
Past Simple	→	Past Simple/Past Perfect
Past Continuous	→	Past Perfect Continuous/
Present Perfect	→	Past Perfect
Past Perfect	→	Past Perfect
will	→	would +infinitive
would	→	would +infinitive
can	→	could+infinitive
could	→	could+infinitive
shall	→	should+infinitive
should	→	should+infinitive
might	→	might+infinitive
must	→	must/had to
may	→	might



Say Tell Ask

- **Say** something
She said she had bought a new phone.
- **Tell** somebody something
She told me she would visit her relatives.
- **Tell** somebody to do something, give an order
She told him to be on time.
- **Ask** somebody to do something politely
He asked me to help him.

Reported questions

Special questions

Question Word + Subject + verb

She asked where I had bought that dress.

General questions

If/Whether + Subject + Verb

He asked if/whether someone had called.

<i>now</i>	– <i>then</i>
<i>today</i>	– <i>that day</i>
<i>tonight</i>	– <i>that night</i>
<i>last night</i>	– <i>the night before</i>
<i>tomorrow</i>	– <i>the next day</i>
<i>yesterday</i>	– <i>the day before</i>
<i>this week</i>	– <i>that week</i>
<i>next week</i>	– <i>the next week</i>
<i>here</i>	– <i>there</i>
<i>last night</i>	– <i>the night before</i>
<i>last week</i>	– <i>the previous week/ the week before</i>
