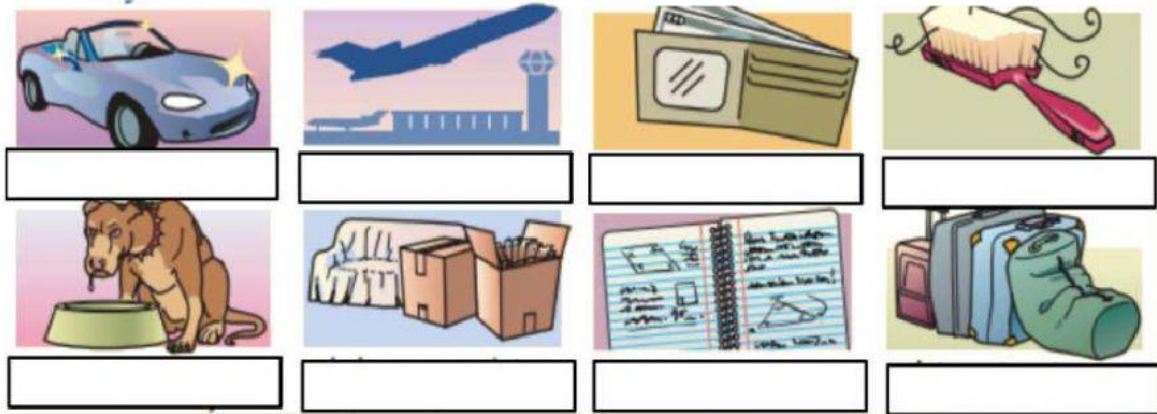


Favors People Dislike Being Asked

Requests

Can you **feed** my cat, please?

Could you please **get** my mail?

Would you **pick** me up at the airport?

Would you **mind** **picking** me up at the airport?



- ✓ A request is a polite form to ask for...
a favor / command
- ✓ To structure the question we use...
would / will / do / can / sub / verb / if / com
- ✓ When we use "would you mind..." the verb is in
simple past / past participle / ing form
