Anais 's skate = The skate of Anais

Agnes 's teddy bear = The teddy bear of Agnes

The Rosales ' parents = The parents of the Rosales

The brothers' school = The school of the brothers

III) Para Plurales que no terminan en S, Agregar Apóstrofe "'S"

The Children 's rabbit = The rabbit of the Children
