"If it wasn't for Mr Daud, we would have never known it was leaking," said Mrs Wong, the homeowner. "You often hear about houses having gas explosions because of a leakage, so he really saved us from a dangerous situation."

"Postmen are out in the community almost every day and are the caretakers of the community," said Mr Ezudin, the chief of Pos Malaysia during the award giving ceremony. "It is just part of the job, being a person and looking after your neighbourhood," he added.
