WE COMMONLY USE "WILL" OR "GOING TO" WHEN WE TALK ABOUT THE FUTURE. HOWEVER, IT IS ALSO POSSIBLE TO USE THE PRESENT CONTINUOUS (VERB BE + ING) FOR TALKING ABOUT ARRANGEMENTS THAT ARE ALREADY PLANNED.
