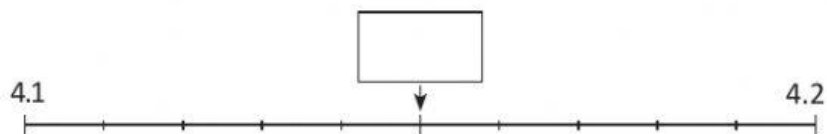

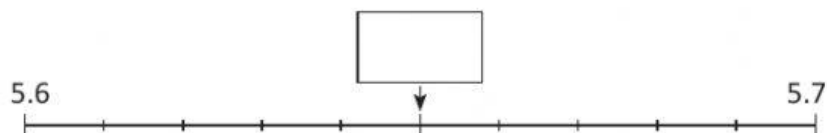

Write the halfway number on each of these numberlines.

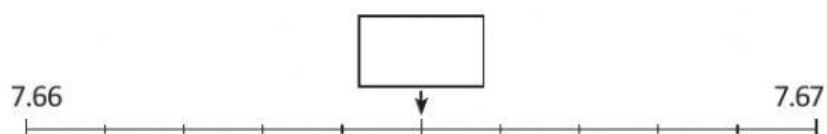
