Reminder:

Regular verbs : verbal root + -ed

Irregular verbs: must be learnt

⚠ Negative and interrogative forms: we must use the auxiliary verb **DID**

— subject + DID not (didn't) + verbal root

? DID + subject + verbal root + ?
