Dear Ricardo,

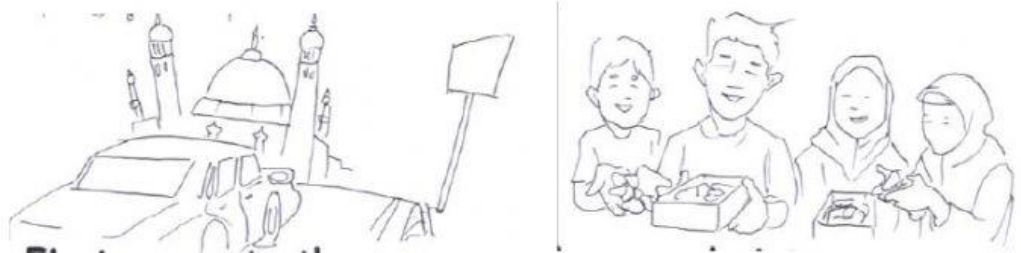

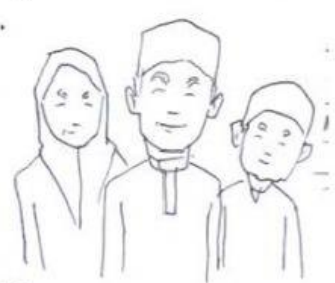
Dear Richardo,
