

There are eight planets in our solar system: Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune.

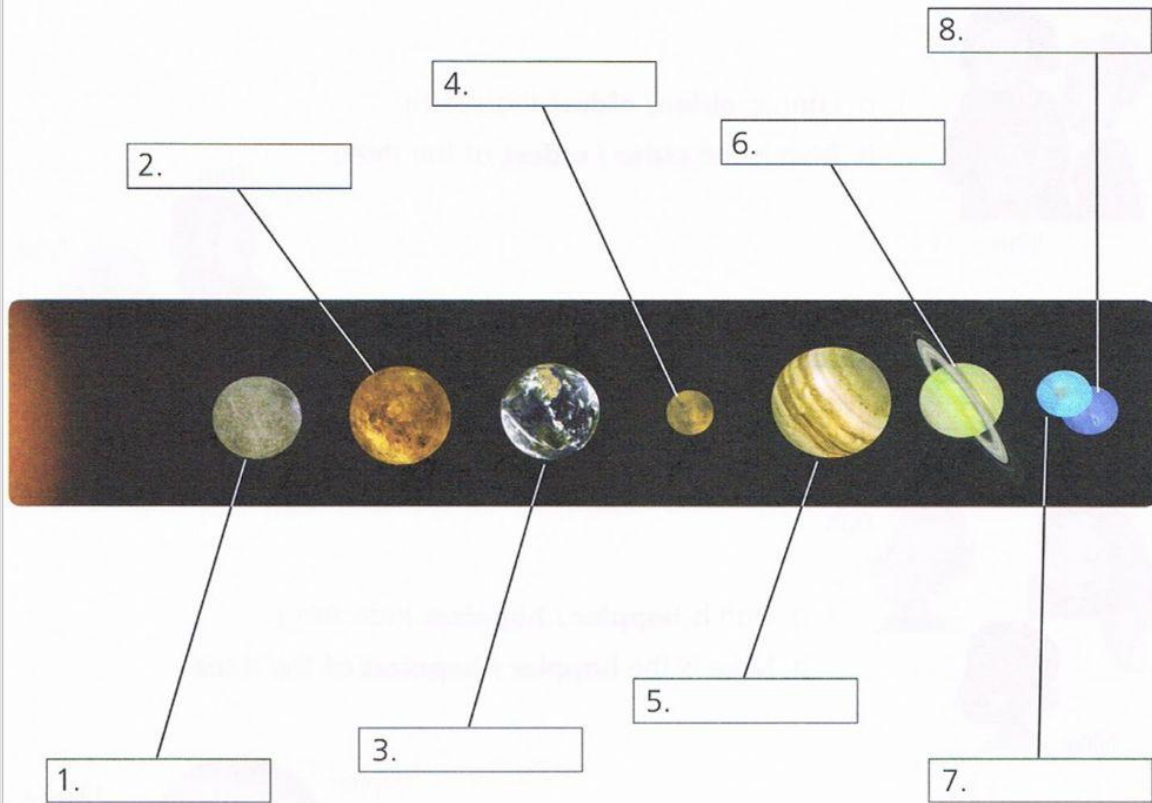
The sun is at the centre of our solar system. It is a star and all the planets go around it.
