



# PAST TENSES:

## (Past Simple, Past Continuous and Past Perfect)

**A quick tip:** We use **past simple** tense for referring to a completed action in the past; **past continuous** tense for referring to a continuous action going on at a specific time in the past and **past perfect** tense for referring to an action which happened before another past action.
