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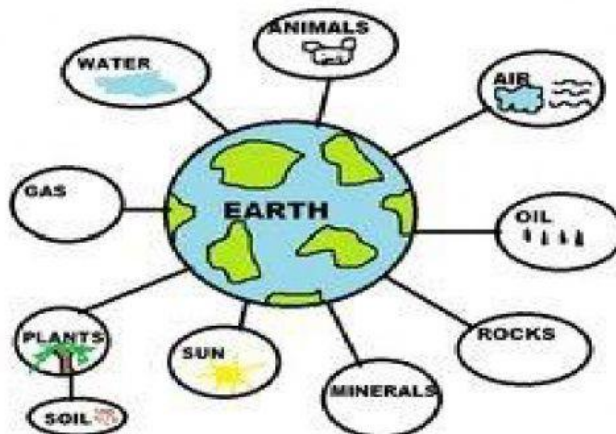

1. Materials which are useful for us are called resources. What is the difference between natural resources and man-made resources?

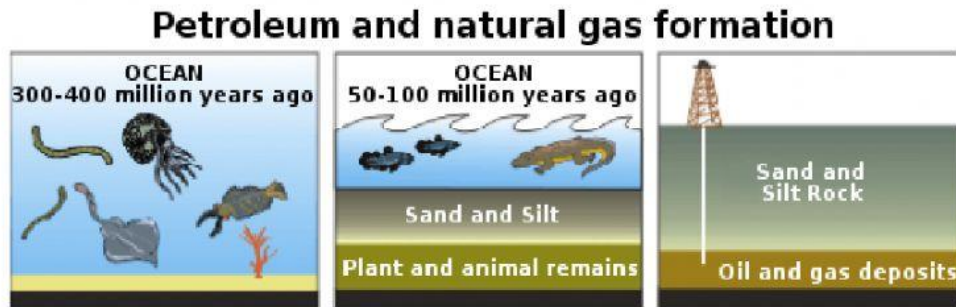

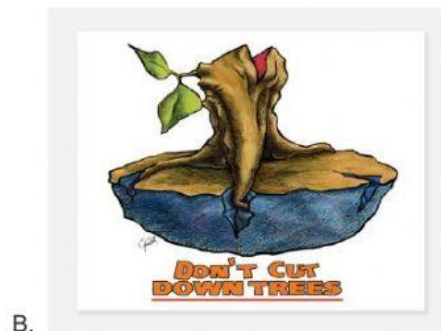
