PARENT TIP!

Remind your child that one symbol equals 6 cakes and half a symbol equals 3 cakes. Encourage them to count in 6s to work out the answers.

Answers: 17
Thursday: 21. Monday: 30. Over the whole weekend: 117
Sarah is right because $\frac{1}{2}$ is half of 5 / She is right because 30 were sold on Monday and 15 were sold on Tuesday. 42 cupcakes were sold on Friday.
