It's <b>going to rain</b>.</p> </div> <div style="border: 1px solid blue; padding: 5px;"> <p style="text-align: center; font-size: x-small; color: blue;">decisions (taken before now - intentions/plans)</p> <p>➔ Are you <b>going to watch</b> the game tonight?</p> </div>	<p style="text-align: center; color: orange; font-weight: bold;">present simple</p> <div style="border: 1px solid orange; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 5px;"> <p style="text-align: center; font-size: x-small; color: orange;">timetabled events</p> <p>➔ The train <b>leaves</b> at 4 o'clock.</p> <p>➔ The exams <b>start</b> next week.</p> </div> <div style="border: 1px solid orange; padding: 5px;"> <p style="text-align: center; font-size: x-small; color: orange;">future time clauses (when/ as soon as/until, etc.)</p> <p>➔ I'll retire <b>when I am</b> 70. (NOT <b>when I'll be</b> 70).</p> <p>➔ Call me as soon as you <b>arrive</b>.</p> </div>

<div style="border: 1px solid purple; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 5px;"> <p style="text-align: center; font-size: x-small; color: purple;">plans (arrangements have been made)</p> <p>➔ I'm <b>flying</b> to New York tomorrow morning.</p> <p>➔ I'm <b>seeing</b> the dentist at 6.</p> <p>➔ We <b>are getting</b> married next week.</p> </div>		
<div style="border: 1px solid yellow; padding: 5px;"> <p style="text-align: center; color: yellow; font-weight: bold;">may / might</p> <p style="font-size: x-small; color: yellow;">Use <b>may</b> or <b>might</b> to talk about future possibility</p> <p>➔ I <b>might go</b> to the party tomorrow; I'm not sure.</p> <p>➔ Temperatures <b>might go up</b> next week</p> </div>
