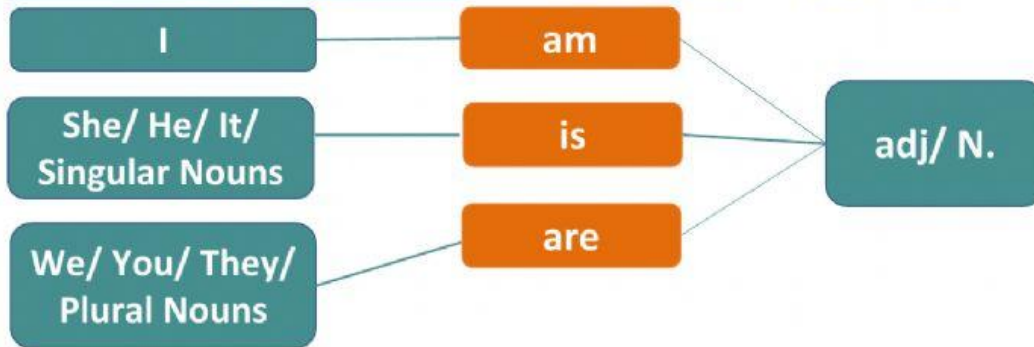


Present Simple**All Forms – Verb “BE”**

Động từ “be”	• He/ She/ It/ singular nouns	+ isn't	+ adj/ N.
	• I	+ am not	+ adj/ N.
	• We/ You/ They/ plural nouns	+ aren't	+ adj/ N.

Y/N questions Verb “be”	• Is + he/ she/ it/ singular nouns	+ adj/ N?
	• Am + I	+ adj/ N?
	• Are + we/ you/ they/ plural nouns	+ adj/ N?

• Yes, I am.

• No, I'm not.

• Yes, he/she is.

• No, he/she isn't.

• Yes, you/ we/ they are.

• No, you/ we/ they aren't.

Động từ thường

- I/ We/ You/ They/ plural nouns + **don't** + V infinitive.
- He/ She/ It/ singular nouns + **doesn't** + V infinitive.

Change **y** to **ies**
(not for: play, say)

Y/N questions
Ordinary verbs

- Do + I/ we/ you/ they/ plural nouns + V infinitive?
- Does + he/ she/ it/ singular nouns + V infinitive?

- Yes, I do.
- No, I don't.
- Yes, he/she/ it does.
- No, he/she/ it doesn't.
- Yes, you/ we/ they do.
- No, you/ we/ they don't.

There are three ways to pronounce the "s" and "es" endings:

V_s / V_es
