Moses had been leading God's people for a long time. Soon Moses died. Who would be the leader of God's people then?

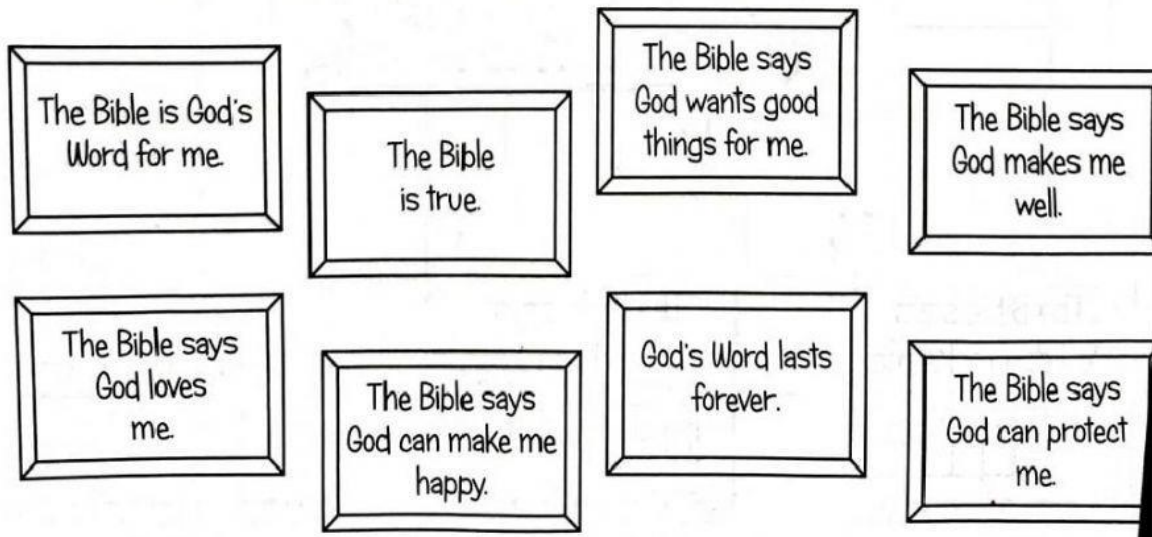
God spoke to Moses' assistant, a man named Joshua. God said, "My servant Moses is dead. I want you to lead my people."
