Phrasal Verb	Meaning
Jazz up	To add a new recording over previously recorded material
Belt out	To be recorded or remembered in a particular way
Dub over	To become interested in an activity or subject
Drown out	To cause a device to operate
Book into	To sing or play a song loudly and forcefully
Chill out	To watch or listen to a television or radio broadcast.
Go down	To make reservation
Get into	To make something more interesting, lively, or exciting
Put on	To relax
Tune into	To be loud enough to block the sound of something else
