ARE THE SPIDERS INSECTS?

Spiders are not insects! They are <sup>123</sup> arachnids - invertebrates (animals without backbones) that have eight legs and which inject venom. Spiders are <sup>124</sup> on every continent except Antarctica. There are over 44,000 known kinds <sup>125</sup> spiders. Spiders are found in every kind of habitat and are often found in homes! Spiders are unique among animals in that many spin webs out of

silk. The webs trap insects and other prey to be **126** later. Larger spiders, such as wolf spiders, huntsman, and tarantulas attack prey **127** than spin webs. One spider that was recently **128** even flings itself at prey like a slingshot! Most spiders eat insects, but tarantulas and larger spiders will eat small lizards and mammals as **129**.
