Turtles are found all over the world. They are reptiles. They are cold-blooded and they lay eggs. They have hard shells. The shells are covered with scales. Many turtles can pull their heads, four legs and tails into their shells. Sea turtles, however, cannot do that.

Turtles also have four flipper-like legs and they are good swimmers. They have beaks and they are toothless. They also have no external ears. Instead, they have two small holes on the sides of the head.

Most Sea Turtles are carnivores or meat-eaters. They eat small fish, shellfish, lobsters, crabs and shrimps. Green Turtles are herbivores. They eat plants such as sea grass and algae. Snapping Turtles are **omnivores** and they eat plants, small fish, frogs, insects, snakes, and even dead animals that they find.
