Indication : For treatment of a wide-range of diarrhea.

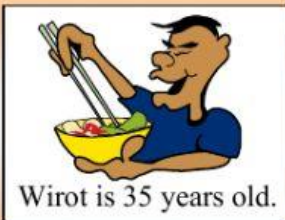
Dosage : Adult 1-2 tablets every 4-6 hours.

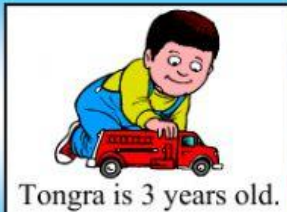

Keep out of the reach of children.

Should be kept at a temperature not exceeding 35 °C

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PARACETAMOL TABLETS

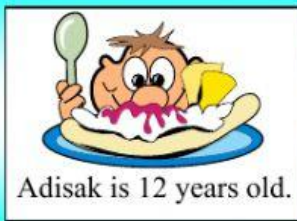
500 Mg.
