LET'S UNDERSTAND

Let's learn more about **MODAL VERBS "FOR RULES"**:

MODAL VERB	Expresses...	Example
CAN	Permission	- Children can play in this place. - We can bring our own food.
CAN'T	Prohibition	- They can't park their cars here. - Parents can't miss the school meetings.
MUST	Obligation (Personal perception)	- We must present our homework on time. - I must recycle to save the planet.
MUSTN'T	Prohibition	- People mustn't speak loudly in a hospital. - We mustn't smoke in this building.
HAVE TO	Obligation (External)	- We have to do our homework until Thursday. - Parents have to guarantee their children's education.
DON'T / DOESN'T HAVE TO	Not necessary	- You don't have to wear uniforms in that school. - He doesn't have to come tomorrow.
