## Prefixes and Suffixes (re-, un-, -ful, -ly, -er)

A **prefix** is a word part added to the beginning of a base word. It adds meaning to the base word.

| Prefix | Base Word | New Word         | Meaning       |
|--------|-----------|------------------|---------------|
| re-    | + make    | = <b>remake</b>  | to make again |
| un-    | + happy   | = <b>unhappy</b> | not happy     |


A **suffix** is a word part added to the end of a base word. It also adds meaning to the base word.

| Base Word | Suffix | New Word          | Meaning           |
|-----------|--------|-------------------|-------------------|
| care      | + -ful | = <b>careful</b>  | full of care      |
| friend    | + -ly  | = <b>friendly</b> | in a friendly way |
| help      | + -er  | = <b>helper</b>   | one who helps     |
