

Nasal cavity	A. The voice box, located in the throat, contains the vocal cords
Hard Palate	B. The soft portion of the roof of the mouth, lying behind the hard palate. The tongue hits the velum in the sound /k/ or /g/
Larynx	C. The small, dangly thing at the back of the soft palate
Alveolar ridge	D. At its top end, it is divided into 2: back of the mouth and the beginning of the way through nasal cavity
Velum	E. Two small bands of muscles within the larynx
Nose	F. The part of the mouth behind gums and teeth that is bounded above by the hard and soft palates and below by the tongue
Vocal cords	G. The two openings at the end of the nose that you breathe through
Oral cavity	H. Between the top front teeth and the hard palate
Epiglottis	I. The two soft edges at the opening to the mouth
Pharynx	J. The opening between the vocal cords
Tongue root	K. Located in the throat behind the tongue and in front of the larynx
Lips	L. A large air-filled space above and behind the nose in the middle of the face
Glottis	M. The part at the back and bottom of the tongue, forming the front wall of the pharynx
Uvula	N. The roof of the mouth, smooth curved surface
