There are seven pencils and three rulers in the drawer. Jessica placed eight more pencils in the drawer. How many pencils are now there in all?	
Sam found seven seashells but two were broken. How many unbroken seashells did Sam find?	
Benny has 8 green balloons but lost 2 of them. How many green balloons does Benny have now?	
There are seven dogwood trees and three walnut trees currently in the park. Park workers will plant six more dogwood trees today. How many dogwood trees will the park have when the workers are finished?	
There were a total of nine baseball games this year. Tim missed four of the games. How many baseball games did Tim go to in all?	
Melanie had 2 quarters and 8 nickels in her bank. Her sister borrowed 4 nickels. How many nickels does Melanie have now?	
Dan picked 6 oranges and Fred picked 2 oranges from the orange tree. Joan picked 9 limes from the lime tree. How many oranges were picked in all?	
Benny's cat had 7 kittens. He gave 2 to his friends. How many kittens does he have now?	
Tom grew seven carrots. Sandy grew four carrots. How many carrots did they grow in all?	
A restaurant served 2 sandwiches during lunch and 7 during dinner today. It served 4 of them yesterday. How many sandwiches were served today?
