a/an + Noun

- ① A noun is a word that names a person, animal, place, or thing.
 ② The words **a** and **an** usually come before singular nouns.
A is placed before consonant sounds, and **an** before vowel sounds.

- ③ There are twenty-one consonants and five vowels in the English alphabet.
